Species determination in the middle of the river

Place: Goldersbach near Bebenhausen

Date: 20/July/2019

 Participants: Salamander children group of the NABU Tübingen including supervisors and the NABU with the CNCC.

What happened:

1. Experiencing 150 m of the Goldersbach

2. Determining and explaining the found species

Procedure and insights

Expectations: Introducing activities of a children group managed by an honorary conservation club.

Procedure: The salamander children group waded the little river Goldersbach with all participants.

The different species found were collected or pictures taken. If possible direct determination was envisaged.

After the river walk unknown species were determined and their function explained to the children.

Already in the river intense discussions and interactions evolved between all participants.

Educative methods:

Interactive teaching method: Learning by experience. Experiencing the river with all senses.

Didactic methods: Explanations to the found species with text and picture material.

Intercultural insights:

In terms of the children behavior the guests appreciated that they were:

- very careful in touching all species.
- showed great interest and curiosity for all species.
- had no fear of possible dangers in the river.
